
2/7/1978 - Anthony Kiedrowski could not find evidence of the 3" Iron Pipe due to the are being recently bulldozed. He set a 2" X 44" Iron Pipe with Brass Cap by computed traverse from adjacent found corners and tied out.

10/10/2019 - I found the 2.25" Iron Pipe with 3.0" Brass Cap as described by Kiedrowski leaning in a mound of stones. I was able to determine a definite point of entry of the pipe and set a 1.0" Aluminum Rod with 3.25" Aluminum Cap in its place. I found a snag to the southeast with blue paint marked "BT". I set out four new ties as shown below.
