1982 - William Kelly notes "4" iron pipe, found in place, 12" below surface. Set railroad spike over iron pipe."
Kelly made ties and filed a tie sheet.

2023 - I found railroad spike set by Kelly 2" below road surface. Location matches previous survey work in the area.




