

U.S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

History of original corner establishment and subsequent restorations and description of any record, monument, occupational, testimonial or other evidence considered:

July 24, 1857, A. Millard, set post and established 4 B.T.s; Tamarack 14" N.85°W. 16 lks.; Hemlock 12" N.47°E. 32 lks.; Spruce 8 " S.82°E. 10 lks.; Spruce 12" S.15°W. 66 lks.;

In 1986, W. Kelly found a well point and 1 old B.T. a Cedar 14" N.72°W. 9.60'; he established 3 new B.T.s; a Spruce 8" S.79°E. 49.00'; a Y. Birch 8" S.76°E. 50.80' and a Spruce 10" S.12°e. 66.20'; he replaced well point with a 2½" alum. post with cap;

In 1991, I found the 2½" alum. post and 2 remaining B.T.s; corner lcoated in ancient fallen, E.-W. fence.

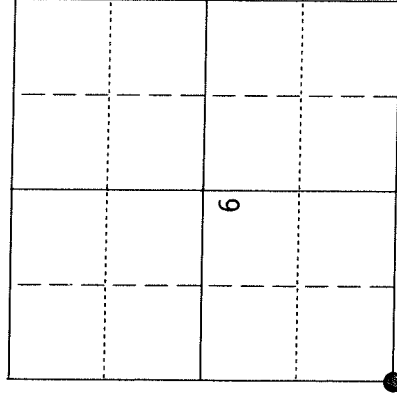

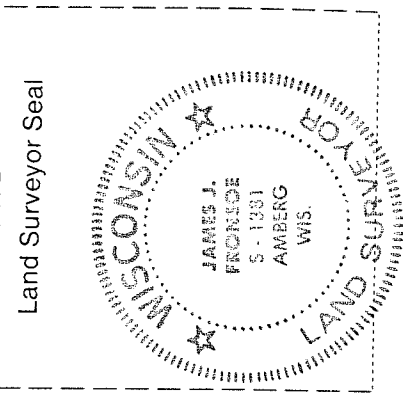
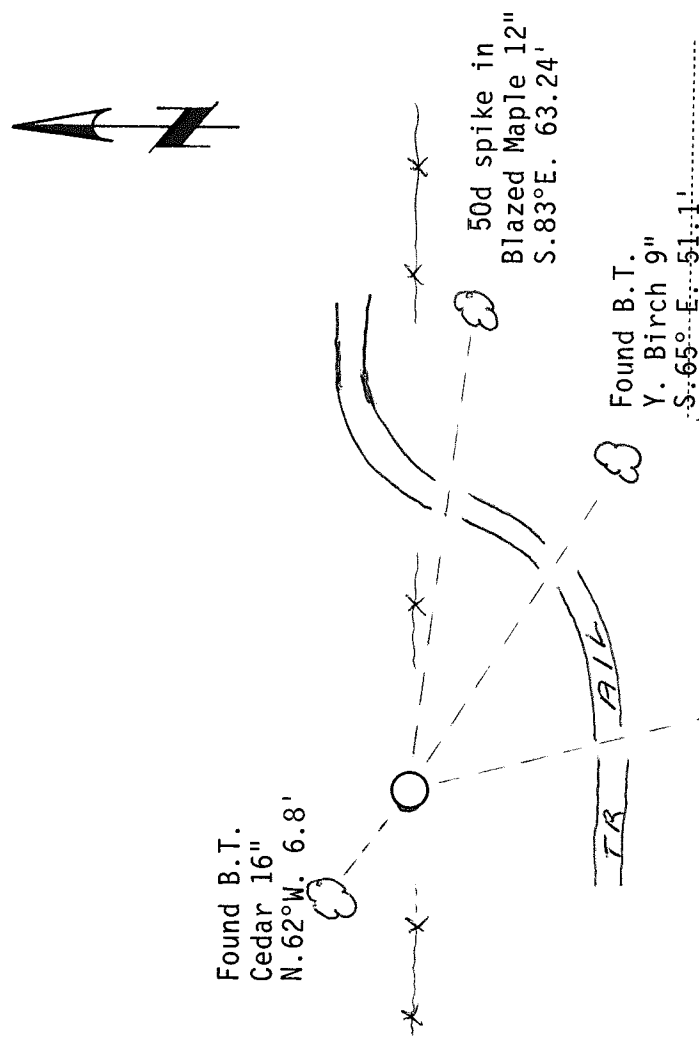
