

U.S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

(As Required By s. A-E 5.02, WI Adm. Code)

History of original corner establishment and subsequent restorations and description of any record, monument, occupational, testimonial or other evidence considered:

In 1857, A. Millard, Dep. Surveyor, set post and established 2 B.T.s; an Ironwood 8" N.33°W. 23 lks. and a Sugar 11" S.70°E. 6 lks.

No further record evidence was found;

In 1991, I found an ancient fence corner with fences running N., E. & W. from corner, found no evidence of original corner stake or accessories. According to local residents this fence corner has been the property corner for as long as any remember.

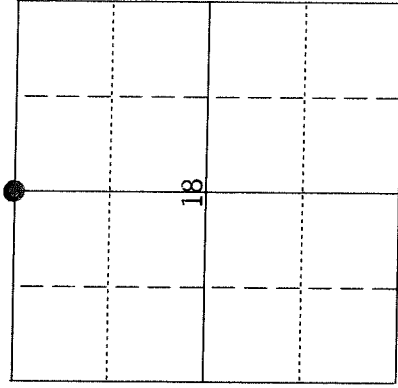

I accept a point 1' South of the center of the fence corner post as the best remaining evidence of the corner location and set a 2½" alum. post with cap at this location; referenced as shown below.

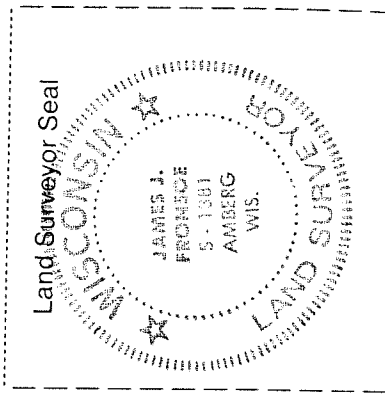
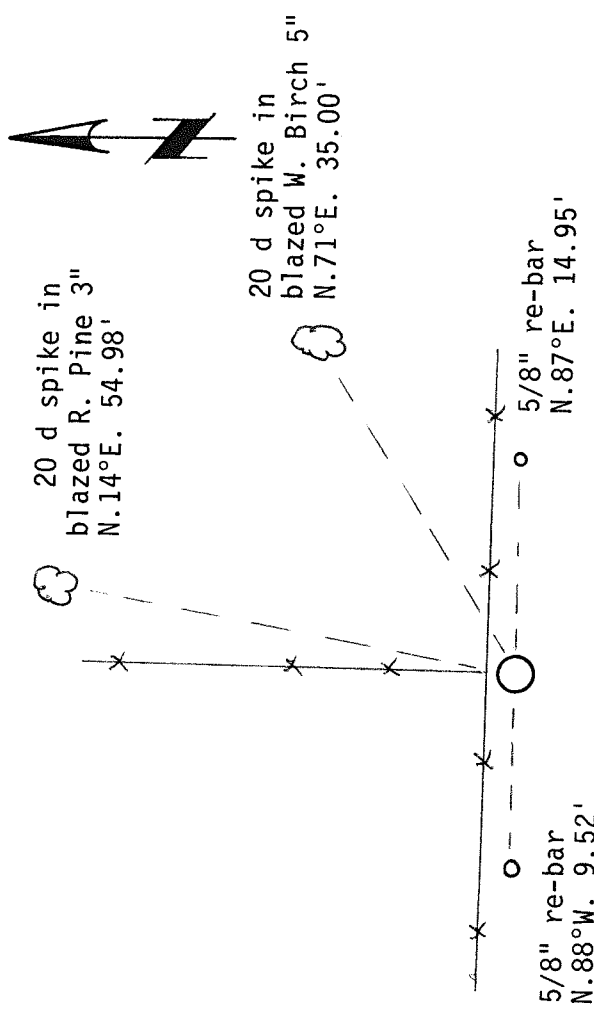
The N. ¼
