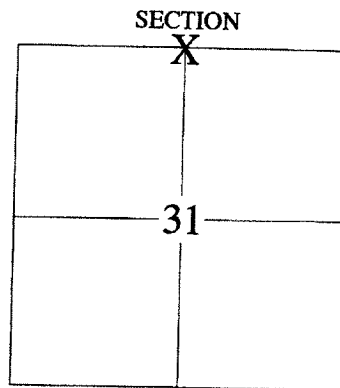

**BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION:**

1977: W. STUTH FOUND REMAINS OF A 3" CEDAR STAKE BELOW ROAD SURFACE DURING A CONTROL SURVEY OF SECTION 30 FOR OWENS-ILLINOIS. W. DUPKE, A FORMER AREA FARMER, CLAIMED THIS CORNER WAS SET PRIOR TO THE 1920'S WHEN THE NORTH-SOUTH FENCE LINE WAS LAID OUT. THE DISTANCE TO THE WEST IS CONSIDERABLY SHORTER THAN THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT DISTANCES.

1977: WILLIAM KELLY FOUND REMAINS OF A 3" CEDAR STAKE BELOW ROAD SURFACE. HE RESET A 2" IRON PIPE WITH A BRASS CAP AND TIED OUT THE CORNER.

2017: I FOUND THE 2" PIPE SET BY KELLY DISTURBED FROM ROAD CONSTRUCTION LAYING IN THE DITCH TO THE NORTH. ALL BLAZE TREES FROM KELLY'S TIE SHEET WERE GONE. I USED THE ANGLES FROM STUTH'S (OWENS-ILLINOIS) CONTROL SURVEY OF SECTION 30 AND PRORATED THE DISTANCES TO REESTABLISH THE POSITION OF THIS CORNER AND SET A 60D SPIKE. THIS POSITION FITS THE CENTERLINE OF 1ST AVENUE AND THE POSSESSION LINE TO THE NORTH. I SET 4 TIES AS SHOWN BELOW.
