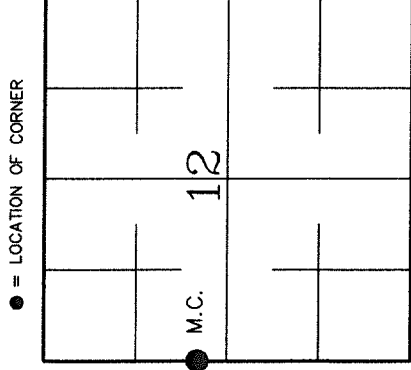

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT AND SUBSEQUENT RESTORATION AND DESCRIPTION OF ANY RECORD, MONUMENT OCCUPATIONAL, TESTIMONIAL OR OTHER EVIDENCE CONSIDERED:

This Meander Corner was set in 1860 by Hiram C. Fellows. Original Bearing Trees: 12" Hemlock N55W 20lks, 12" Hemlock, N15E, 27lks. In March, 1882, B.F. Dorr mentions "M.C. on North Shore" as he was running the West Line of Section 12. D.A. Hintz, doing Resurvey work in 1939, mentions "Galv. iron pipe by Co. Surveyor on North side of lake" in referring to the M.C. He replaced the pipe with a 4" Brass Capped Monument. On 6/26/98, Gerry Bahar and Becky Bahar used this M.C. for survey work in Sec 12 and tied it out.

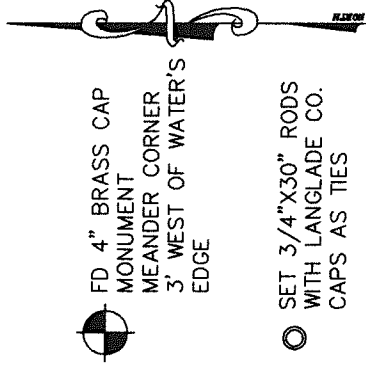
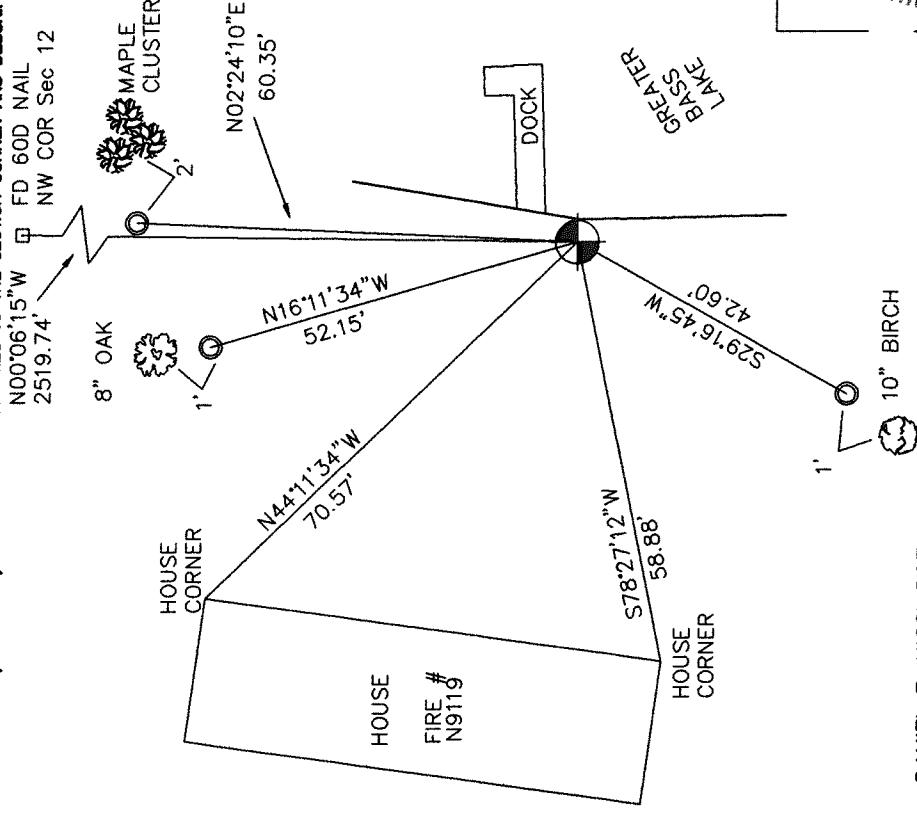

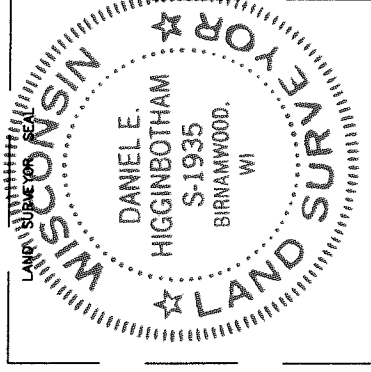
