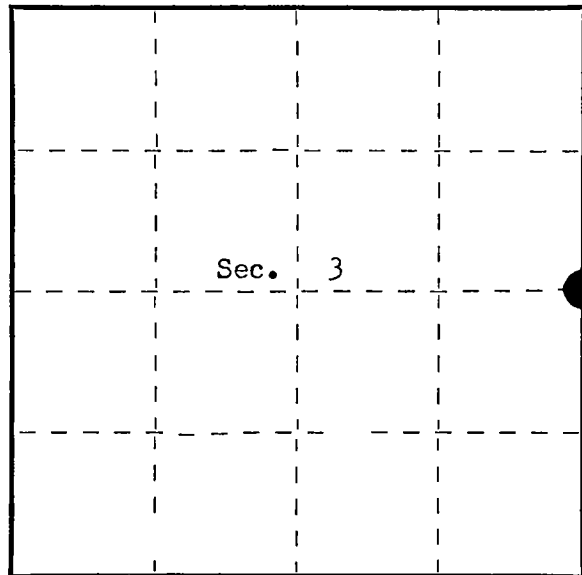

Resvick, do hereby certify that on the 17th day of October, 1962, I found evidence of the quarter corner of sections 2 and 3 Township 33 North, Range 14 East, North, Range 14 East, Fourth Principal Meridian, as described hereon; and that from this evidence I established a new monument and accessories as described hereon to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

History of original corner establishment:

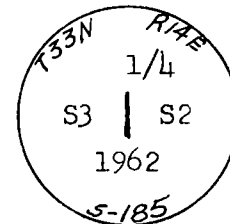
Subdivision of township surveyed in 1865 by James L. Nowlin
South corrected between section 2 & 3, 42.50 chains
Set wood post
Sugar 10", N 28 E, 8 lks.
Sugar 7 ", N 19 W, 12 lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

- 1. 5x5 squared cedar post 2 ft. long, scribed
- 2. Post was found in mound of rock with bottom rotted off, point of post found below rocks.
- 3. Sugar 19", N28E, 5.28 ft. (8lks.). Tree has many blazes and is hollow.
- 4. Sugar stump 14", N19W, 7.9 ft. (12 lks.).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Replaced point of cedar post with galvanized Iron pipe 5 feet long, 2 ins. inside diameter, filled with concrete and flanged at bottom with brass cap marked from which the following new bearing trees bear:



- y. birch 7", N05° 30' W, 28 lks.
- elm 4", N 76° 30' E, 15 lks.
- elm 8", S 28° E, 7 1/4 lks.
- sugar 10", S78W, 39 lks.

Drain to Glade Lake 50.0 ft. North
Area cover with many rock with high ground to south.
