

The original corner was established in 1865 by James L. Nowlin. Original bearing trees: birch, 6", N45°W, 17 lks., and a birch, 6", S65°E, 3 lks. In 1937 Hintz described this corner as: "To original 1/4 corner, remains of original BT birch, 12", S50°E, 24 lks. New BO: stone, West, 14.1 lks." In 1975, former surveyor Kelly found 4" brass cap set in concrete in a pipe (iron). Corner is located on edge of a ridge in a stand of hardwoods. Made 3 new BT's: w. birch, 6", S57°W, 11.30'; w. birch, 8", N63°W, 9.57' and a hard maple, 6", N61°E, 13.50'. On April 21,1998 D. Tlusty, D. Williams found iron pipe with 4" brass cap, straightened it and made solid. Found 1937 stone with chiseled "x" on top, N86°W, 9.2'. Also found old fence north and west (both down) and all Kelly's B.T.'s. Accepted monument found as the best evidence of the original corner location and freshened with blue paint, added B.T. signs and aluminum tie nails in a new low blaze on the side of the trees and remeasured as shown below.


