

The original corner was established in 1865 by James L. Nowlin. Original bearing trees: sugar, 15", N35°W, 30 lks. and a sugar 10", N32°E, 30 lks. 1937, Darwin Hintz described this corner as: To section corner 10-15-16 -9 in road intersection N-S-E-W. Set witness corner brass cap S39°E 61.5 lks. (40.6'), made 2 new BO's: cross on stone, S33°W, 61.5 lks., and a cross on stone, N33°E, 53 lks. In June, 1978, former surveyor Kelly found the 4" iron pipe with brass cap as witness corner. Corner is at a road intersection. Set 1" iron pipe below road surface. Made 3 new BT's, and in 1985 he reset the corner after roadwork. In June, 1998, D. Tlusty, D. Williams found nail and cap in road, set temp. ties and dug in the road. Down 1.75' found a 1" iron pipe in good condition, left as found Accepted the 1" iron pipe as best evidence of corner location.

## Physical description of the monument set:

The corner is approx. 13 feet north of the center of pavement on Moccasin Lake Rd. and approx. 3 feet east of the center of pavement of Enterprise Lake Rd.
