

The stone was referenced on other surveys by Kelly 1974, Abendroth 1991, and Arnott 1998. 1981- Surveyor Ploeger found a 1" iron pipe flush with ground, the 4" brass cap filled with concrete, and the old Yellow Birch BTs. He used the 1" pipe "for true 1/4 corner", and set a 2.5" iron pipe with brass cap 28.92 feet "North of true corner" and tied to a power pole #3410-35L 25, N74°W, 67.51 feet. Apparently Ploeger was at the corner in the winter. He did not indicate looking for or finding Dorr's stone.

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established by J.L. Nowlin, deputy surveyor, in 1865 from which Fir 10" bears N80°W 10 links and Hemlock 6" bears S75°E 12 links. In 1937 Langlade County-surveyors recovered stone and B.F. Dorr's white pine stump 40" S38°E 34.5 links. Marked NBT's - Y. Birch 7" S48°E 32.4 links

Y. Birch 7" S25°E 27.1 links

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered a 1" iron pipe drove flush with the ground for true 1/4 corner.

20 links south of pipe recovered a 4" iron pipe filled with concrete and capped with a 4" brass cap - stamped:

Projecting 18" above ground.

OBT's - Y. Birch 7" S48°E 32.4 links - gone.

Y. Birch 9" S25°E 27.1 links - stump remains.
