History of original corner establishment:

Original survey by J.L. Nowlin in 1865 had 1/4 corner in pond. In 1882 B.F. Dorr, county surveyor, set 1/4 corner from which Tamarack 3" bears S32- $1/2^{\circ}$ W 48 links. Langlade County surveyors in 1937 recovered B.F. Dorr's corner and tamarack B.T. S $32-1/2^{\circ}$ W 48 links.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered an old 4" squared cedar post on west edge of pond. Corner sets $4.0~{\rm ft.}$ west of water.

Post is very old - unable to see any scribed marks on it.

OBT - Tamarack 3" S32°W 48.0 links No evidence of this B.T.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Removed old wood post and replaced with a 2-1/2" iron pipe with screw-on brass cap - stamped:

Projecting 8" above bog.
