





HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT AND SUBSEQUENT RESTORATION AND DESCRIPTION OF ANY RECORD, MONUMENT OCCUPATIONAL, TESTIMONIAL OR OTHER EVIDENCE CONSIDERED:

The Original 1/4 Corner was established in 1859 by William E. Daugherty. Original BT's: 12" Birch, N40W 7lks., 10" Birch S15E 18lks. Door, in 1888, has a distance of 2752.20' (41.70 chains) from the C1/4 to the North 1/4. County Surveyor Brooks, in Sept. of 1905 visited the N1/4 post, found an Original Birch BT and marked a new BT: 10" Hemlock, S381/2E 06 lks. In January 1998, Brinkmeier and Bahar, after finding an occupied Center, found a fence intersection at the location of the N1/4. This intersection was within 6' of Door's 1888 distance, with no other evidence found. We accepted this fence intersection as the location of the N 1/4, set a 1" Iron Pipe and tied it out.



TOWN SHIP 34 NORTH, RANGE 11 EAST




