
## U. S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

INSTRUCTIONS:

This record shall show the location of the corner and shall include all of the following nine elements (a through i).

- (a) Identify the corner by reference to the U.S. public land survey system.
  - O = Corner monument restored.

This corner was originally set by William E. Daugherty and was perpetuated by Robert J. Poss in 1968.



(b) Describe any record evidence, monument evidence, occupational evidence, testimonial evidence or any other material evidence you considered, and whether the monument was found or placed.

We re-tied this corner to perpetuate its location and to make it easier to locate for future users. This WITNESS CORNER is located between a walk area and a retaining wall on the property @ N10898 Circle Drive.
