1859 - Comer originally set by W.E. Daugherty. BT's: Tamarack 10", N29W, 34 links; Tamarack 7", S63E, 19 links

Sept 1905 - E.S. Brooks - (FB94, P10) Surveyed the East line of Section 19. Visited the NE comer - " comer bad. BTs all down." His notes did not indicate what he found for the comer, or if he made any new BTs.

August 1970- RLS Poss found old wood stake, and "found rock with X described by Hutchinson as S76 1/2 W, 52 1/2 links. Poss set two witness comers (2" iron pipe with brass cap) 40' west and 40' east.

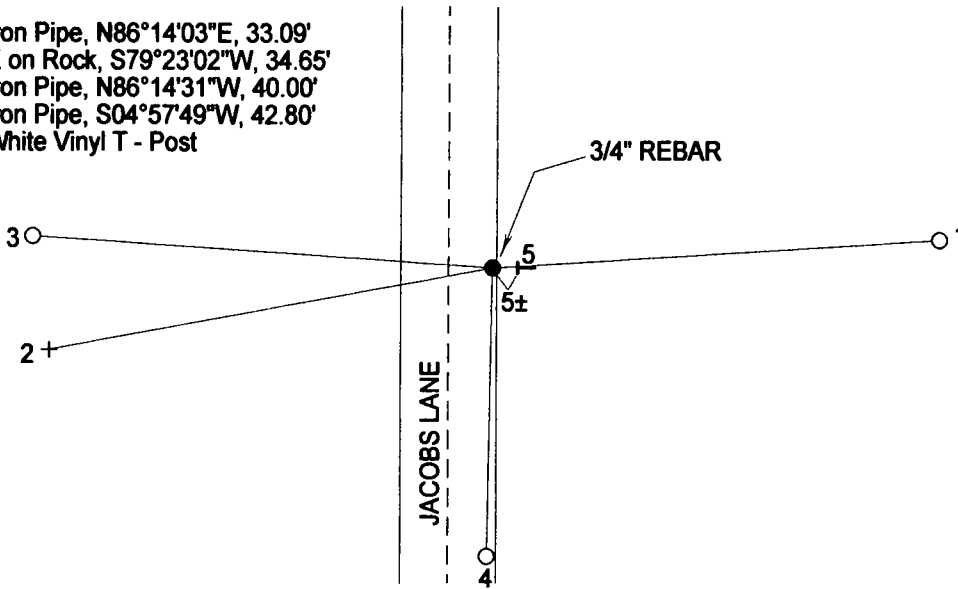
January 2006 - I found the rock with X, Poss's witness to the west in place, and Poss's witness to the east, dislodged. I reset the comer from the existing ties.

### Physical description of the monument set:

I set a 3/4" rebar at the edge of the gravel road, with ties as detailed below.

- 5 - White Vinyl T - Post



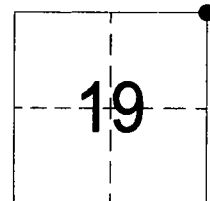
