

Local resident, William Jacobs, showed us the well point and claims that it has been there sense he was a boy. We excepted the well point as the South 1/4. No other evidence was found.






The Original 1/4 Corner was established in 1859 by William E Daugherty. Original BT's: 10" Birch N45W 14lks., 9" Sugar Maple S36E 11lks. In February, 1998 Brinkmeier and Bahar searched for corner. Local resident, William Jacobs, showed us a well point, claiming it was there since he was a boy. No other evidence was found. This location falls within 17' of Dorr's 1883 distance of 47.30 chains from the S1/4 to the C1/4. We found an occupied Center. We accepted this location as best evidence and tied out.
