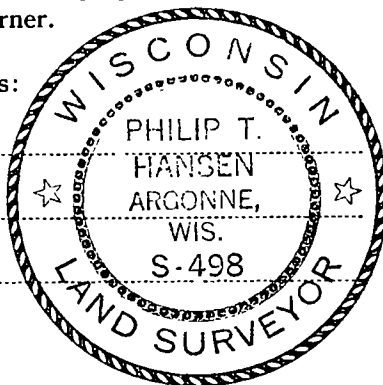

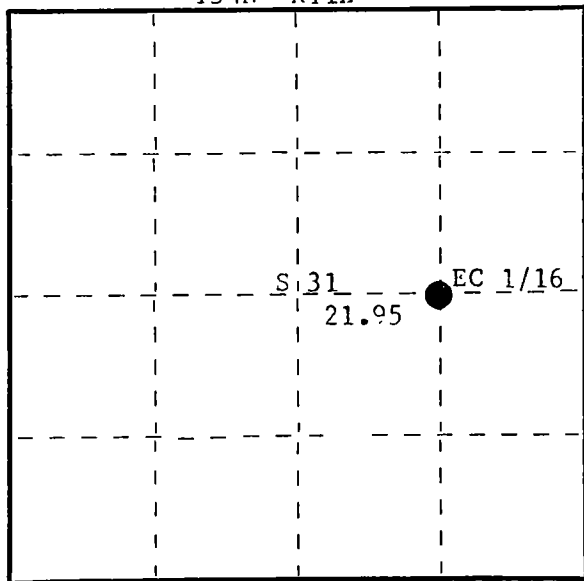

History of original corner establishment:

Origin of this corner unknown.

Charles Borth, State cruiser, ran line from C 1/4 east to E 1/4 corner in 1934. Recovered EC 1/16 corner and hemlock BT 9" N80°W, 5 paces and hemlock 12" S70°E, 2 paces. Set new post.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered 4" cedar post, squared and scribed 1/8 - 1/8, in poor condition.

Recovered OBTs - Hemlock 9" N80°W, 5 paces, 21.8 links, now an 8' stub, notched at bottom, no scribing.

Hemlock 12" S70°E, 2 paces, 8 links, now a 30 ft. stub, notched at bottom, no scribing.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Replaced cedar post with 2" iron pipe with brass cap, stamped:

Monument projects 18" above ground.

Set old post beside new monument.

Marked NBTs - Cedar 7" N34°E, 55 links, scribed 1/16 BT.

Cedar 9" N34°W, 78.7 links, scribed 1/16 BT.
