# U.S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

### HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT AND SUBSEQUENT RESTORATION AND DESCRIPTION OF ANY RECORD, MONUMENT OCCUPATIONAL, TESTIMONIAL OR OTHER EVIDENCE CONSIDERED:

THE ORIGINAL CORNER WAS SET BY J.L. NOLING IN 1859. THE ORIGINAL BEARING TREES WERE:

12" BIRCH N67°E 20 LINKS

8" ASPEN S32°W, 25 LINKS

NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL TREES WAS FOUND.

IN 1930 C.W. BORTH DID A RESURVEY OF MANY OF THE SECTION IN T34N R12E, WHERE HE HAD SET A 4X4 CEDAR POST.

IN MARCH, 1977 KELLY HAD FOUND THE POST AND SET A 2" PIPE WITH CAP IN ITS PLACE WITH BEARING TREES OF:

12" WHITE PINE N88°W 16.25'

12" WHITE PIPE N13°E 13.73'

6" WHITE BIRCH S8°E 20.05'

THE PINES WERE FOUND WITH THE BLAZES OVER GROWN. THE WHITE BIRCH WAS NOT LOCATED.

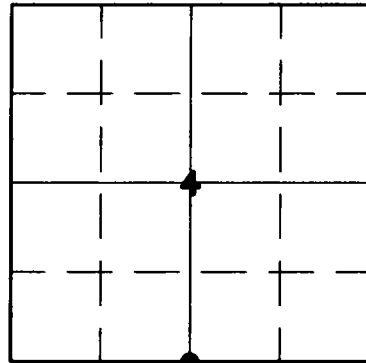
WE DID FIND THE 4X4 POST SET BY BORTH, NOT HUTCHINSON AS KELLY STATES, NEXT TO THE PIPE THAT KELLY HAD SET. RE-TIED THE CORNER WITH 3/4"X24" REBAR AS TIES.

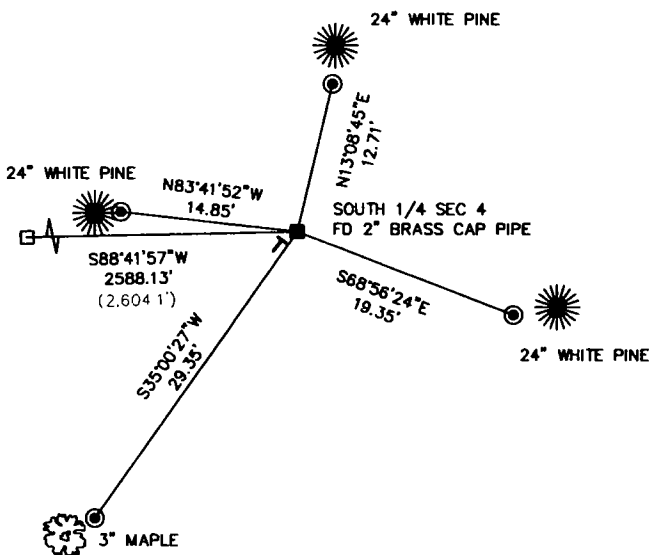

BEARING REFERENCED TO THE LANGLADE COUNTY COORDINATE SYSTEM

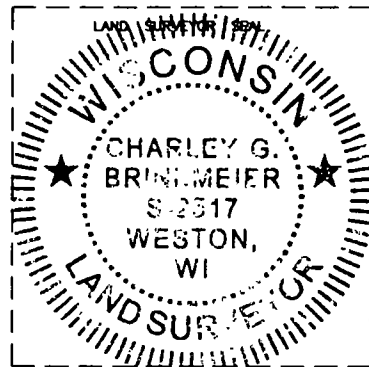

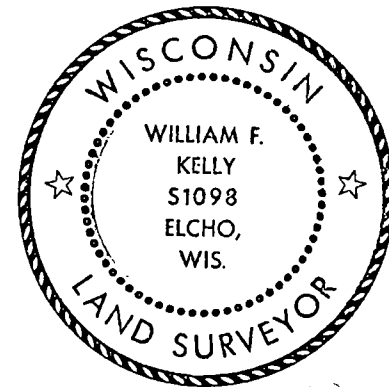

FOUND WOOD POST SET BY M. HUTCHINSON, IDENTIFIED BY RESIDENT WITNESS AS 1/4 CORNER.



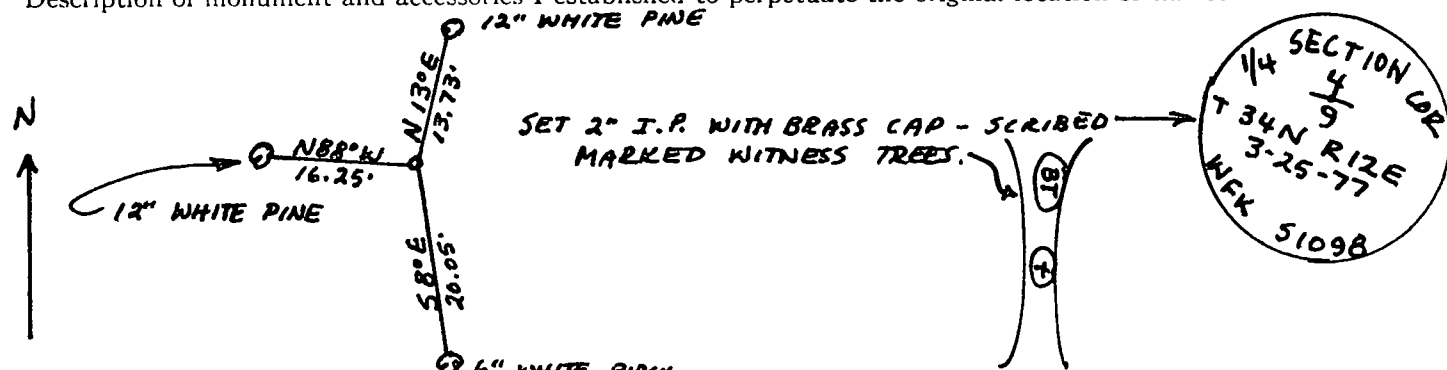
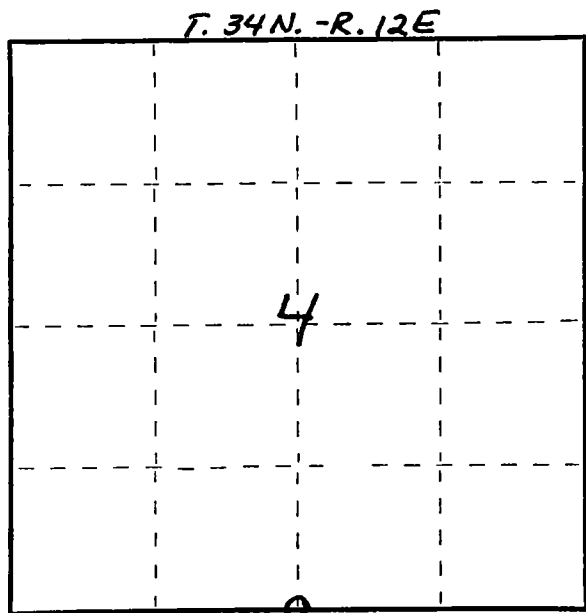
