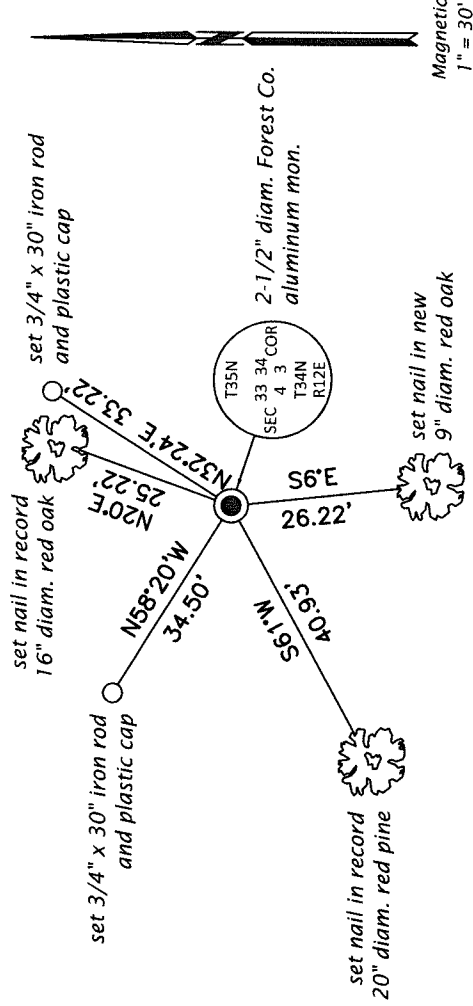
This is a perpetuation of a previous USPLS Monument Record by Thomas R. Arnott, RLS dated November 11, 1975 and filed in the office of the Forest County Register of Deeds. A complete history of the corner can be found on the previous monument record. I accept the previous location as a true and faithful perpetuation or reestablishment of the original corner location and further perpetuate it as follows.

To augment the record:

1932-1934: Survey notes by Charles W. Borth, Langlade County Surveyor Record #10317. "Flat stone with "+" on top. Could not find any original B.T's. Unrecorded BT Norway stump N15°W, 40 ft. Set 3" iron pipe on W. side of stone."

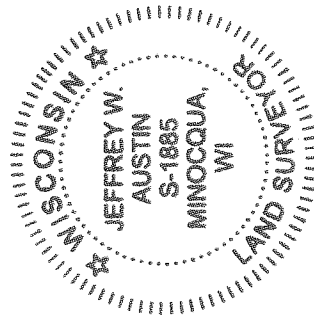
October 22, 2016: I found and accepted a monument of unknown origin, a 2-1/2" diam. aluminum pipe with a 3-1/4" diam. Forest Co. aluminum cap projecting 6" above the ground surface. I set a DEEP-1 magnet adjacent to the monument. As described in the record, a 4" diam. brass-capped iron pipe bears West, 1.3 ft. The record birch and red pine at S14°W are both gone. I found or established accessories as shown below. I set a white vinyl sign post bearing North, 0.7 ft.
